YOUR PROGRAM

Day 1 - Beaches and villages

Starting from Santa Teresa di Gallura, your motorbike adventure will take you to coastline roads and then to inland regions to discover beautiful Italian villages and a Nuraghe, an ancient megalithic edifice which has become the symbol of the island and its distinctive culture, the Nuragic civilization.

Night in a 3 star hotel.

Distance: approximately 75km.

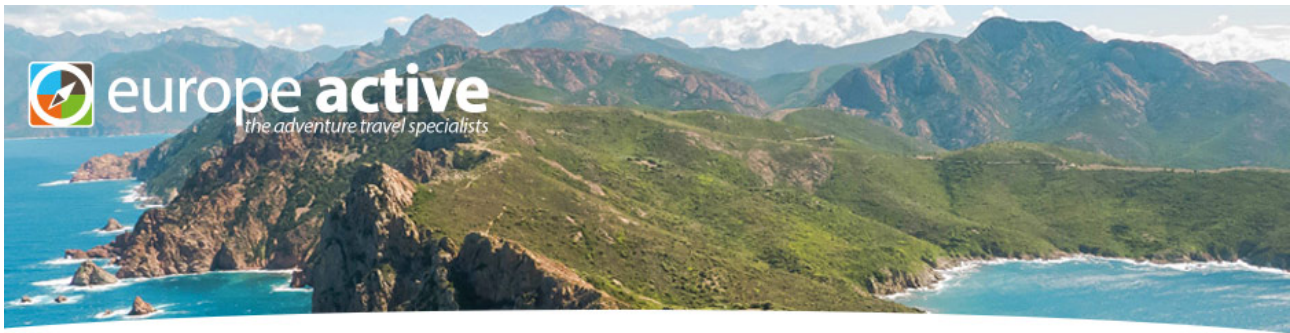


Day 2 - Off the West Coast of Northern Sardinia

After breakfast, hop on your motorbike and speed off to charming little Sardinian villages, with their old churches, beautiful lakes and sea caves. You will finish today's journey near the coastline and stay in a hotel which is five minutes away from the beach.

Night in a 3 star hotel with swimming pool.

Distance: 258km.

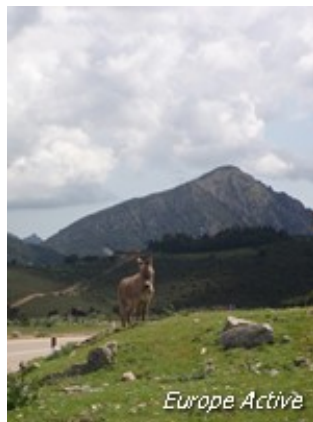


Day 3 - Sardinia's mountains

After breakfast, you will head east and cross the island. You will enter Sardinia's lesser-known regions and come across stunning landscapes. Notice the abounding and grandiose Nurhages in this particular area.

Night and dinner in a 4 star hotel.

Distance: approximately 149km.



Day 4 - The East Coast of Sardinia

Today, you will finish crossing the island and get to reach the East Coast. You will ride through unusually high plateaus and may see wild horses galloping freely through the scenic landscape. You will then reach the seaside town of Cala Gonone where you will be staying for the next two nights.

Night in a 3 star hotel.

Distance: Approximately 200km.

Day 5 - Orgosolo and the Gulf of Orosei

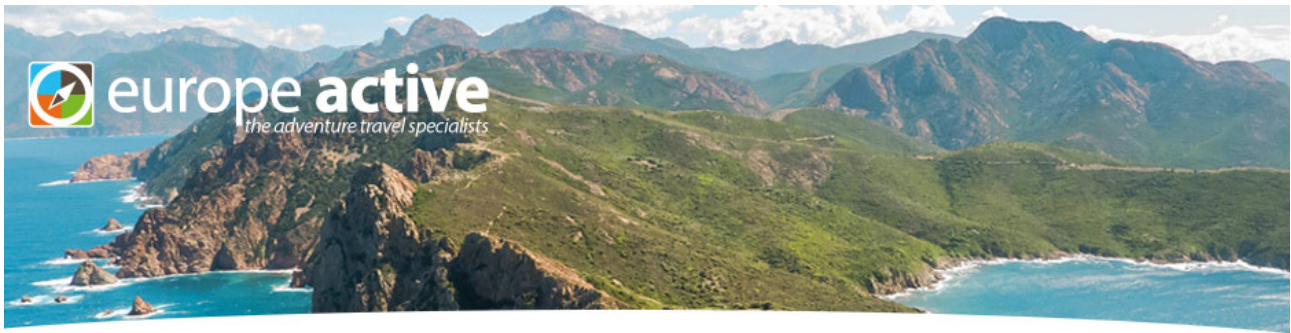
Two different routes are available for this stage.

If you choose the first itinerary, you will be able to visit Orgosolo, a little village which became famous for its murales. These political paintings reflect all the different aspects of Sardinian life and can be found almost everywhere in the village.

The second option is to bask in the sun at the beach or to take a boat trip around the Gulf of Orosei, which is the most beautiful gulf on the island.

Night in the same hotel as the previous night. Don't hesitate to contact us if you wish to stay an extra night in Cala Gonone.

Distance: 125km.



Day 6 - In search of a billionaire's paradise

Today, you will ride northwards along a coastline road which will enable you to discover a more touristic and lively side of Sardinia, with splendid white sandy beaches.

Night in a 3 star hotel in an authentic little village near Porto Cervo.

Distance: 130km.

Day 7 - Your trip ends here

Today's schedule will vary depending on your time of departure.

For your last motorcycling day, you will have the opportunity to ride to Santa Teresa di Gallura (duration: 1h10). If you have enough time, you may want to visit the splendid archipelago of Maddalena.

Distance: approximately 45km.

Your trip ends here.

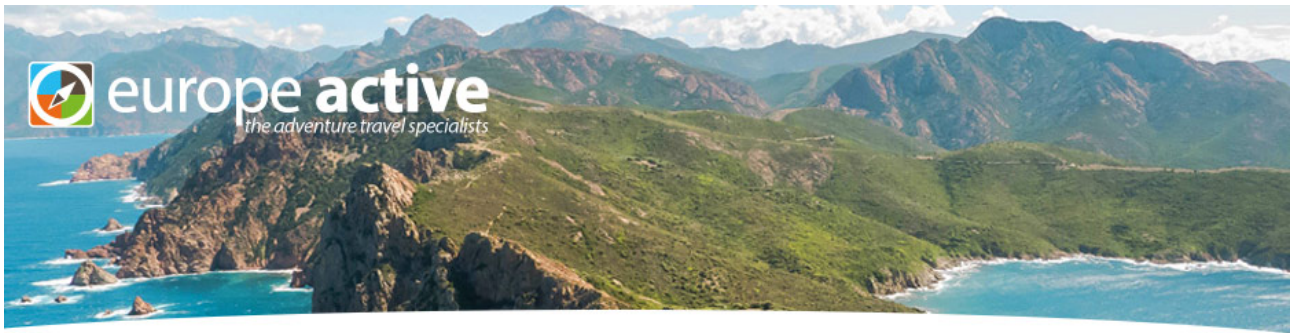
