



## The Monte Serra by mountain bike - luxury version from Pisa to Lucca

3 days/ 2 nights

Get a real taste of Italy and embark on a thrilling short ride on Tuscan roads!

The Monte Serra is a legendary mountain for road cyclists and mountain bikers alike. Culminating at 917m, the Monte Serra acts like a natural barrier separating Pisa from Luca. It also offers many charming little paths and panoramic views over Pisa, Lucca, the Tyrrhenian Coast, the Island of Elba and the National Park of the Cinque Terre.

Ride up towards the sky and descend to the bowels of the earth while exploring every single spot of this wonderful region.

### YOUR PROGRAM

#### Day 1 - Arriving in Pisa

Once you have arrived in Pisa, settle into your hotel and explore the historical centre of Pisa or visit its world-famous leaning tower.

Dinner and night in Pisa.





## Day 2 - Pisa, Lucca and the Monte Serra

After leaving Pisa via a 10km road, get into gear and start a long and physically demanding climb up a road which will offer you great panoramic views. A swooping descent amidst underbrush will take you to the water reserve of Lucca and its remaining ancient stone buildings. Follow the old viaduct and reach the centre of the beautiful fortified town of Lucca via a small path. Explore the battlements and the historical centre of this charming town. Dinner in one of the best Lucchesian restaurants. Night in a hotel in Lucca.

Distance: 40km.

Height gain: 1000m.



## Day 3 - Lucca, Pisa and the Monte Pisano

Continue your cycling adventure and ride off to the Monte Serra via a path that runs along the viaduct. You will pedal your way through a large white path, which will offer you great panoramic views over Lucca and the steep Apennine mountains surrounding Lucca. Ride along the summits of the Monte Pisani and end today's ride with a thrilling descent towards Pisa on single tracks and white paths.

Your trip ends in Pisa.

### TARIFFS

Price from 329 euros per person.

### LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY

Roads and mountain paths. Distance; from 35 and up to 45km. Height gain: approximately 1000m.

You will only need to carry items that you wish to have available during the ride (camera, wallet etc).

### ACCOMMODATION

1 night in a 3 star hotel with swimming pool and 1 night in a 4 star hotel (depending on room availability).
